

AVAILABLE SCHOLARSHIPS AND FINANCIAL AID

St. Anthony Financial Aid

1. All financial obligations must be met and the student account must remain current throughout the year. After thirty (30) days of the student account being delinquent, the financial aid award will be withdrawn for the remainder of the year.
2. Moneys will be applied according to the payment plan.
3. At no time can an award be used to complete a monthly tuition payment or be used to pay fees.
4. If your family is receiving any other type of aid it must be disclosed.
5. If you are awarded any funds by the CEO Foundation or a Horizon Grant your award may be retracted.
6. If for any reason the student is withdrawn, asked to withdraw or expelled from St. Anthony Catholic High School, the amount that has been applied towards the account **must** be paid back to St. Anthony Catholic High School. All moneys must be paid on the date of withdrawal or expulsion and before any transcripts are released.
7. St. Anthony Catholic High School reserves the right to retract the award if the financial aid committee feels that the student is not meeting any of the requirements.
8. The financial aid award is a one time award; you must reapply every year to be considered for assistance.
9. By awarding this financial aid St. Anthony Catholic High School Financial Aid Committee does not guarantee or suggest that a student will receive financial assistance the following year.

Once awarded student is required to:

1. Be a uniformed ambassador on and off campus.
2. Show academic and behavior leadership in classroom.
3. Satisfactorily complete all courses (especially religion).
4. Be on time and in uniform every day.
5. Exceed community service requirements.
6. Attend all Community Masses.

Once awarded parents are encouraged to:

1. Actively participate in the campus community or PTC.
2. Provide 20 hours of school service per year.
3. Attend all Community Masses with their son or daughter.
4. Meet with the Director of Enrollment and Business office manager.

Michael G. Twist Memorial Scholarships

The Michael G. Twist Memorial Scholarship fund has been established in honor of the values and life of Michael G. Twist (SACHS 2005). The 2007-2008 Michael G. Twist Scholarship Program is intended to provide up to \$2,000 in Scholarships for qualified seniors. Criteria include:

1. A student who supported the community through a generous commitment of community service. That is, the student has documented service hours in excess of the minimum required for completion of the third year at St. Anthony.
2. A student who has made efforts to improve self. In an essay, discuss how the student has worked on personal growth and self-improvement (spiritual, behavioral, character, mentoring). Examples of discussion areas might include but are not limited to how the student worked to change values, change behavior, and worked to make positive character changes.
3. A student with demonstrated financial need.
4. A student who has served as a volunteer in the Twist Music Festival (dates, times, action).

Selection: The goal is to provide two students with Scholarship of up to \$1,000 each. Depending upon the number of qualified applicants, a single grant of up to \$2,000 may be made. Applications screened by the SACHS Administration. Qualified applications reviewed by Michele Twist Cano and any other members of the selection committee.
