HONORS PROGRAM

ADVANCED PLACEMENT PROGRAM

St. Anthony offers Pre-Advanced Placement and Advanced Placement courses. Additionally, students may take advanced math, science, and social studies courses offered through the Early College Connection Program.

BLENDED LEARNING

St. Anthony Blended Learning Courses are available through a partnership with UIW Preparatory. These accelerated courses combine learning within the traditional brick and mortar classroom with an online learning platform to enhance the student's learning capability. Students who take a blended learning course are able to take more courses in a shorter amount of time thus allowing them added opportunities to take Senior Connection and Dual Credit courses. These courses are only available to students enrolled in the Accelerated Blended/Online program.

EARLY COLLEGE CONNECTION COURSES/DUAL CREDIT

Junior and Senior students who have a grade point average of 3.5 (90%) and above may be eligible for dual enrollment classes offered by the University of the Incarnate Word. This program enables students to earn up to 36 hours of college credit while completing their requirements for a high school diploma. Students attend college courses on the University of the Incarnate Word campus. The grades earned in the High School Connection Program are recorded on the student's SACHS transcript and become part of the UIW official college record and transcript.

UIW PREP

Designed to challenge college-bound students, the UIW Prep curriculum offers core, honors/pre-AP, AP, and dual credit courses through the University of the Incarnate Word in the following academic disciplines: English, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Foreign Language, Fine Arts, Religious Studies, Physical Education and CTE Electives. UIW Prep also provides students the opportunity to earn high school credit, college credit, and travel internationally through the Dual Credit Study Abroad Program.

STUDY ABROAD PROGRAM

DUAL CREDIT STUDY ABROAD PROGRAM

This innovative program is open to select Junior and Senior high school students and takes place from March to June. Twice per month, students meet with their instructors for interactive discussion at a University of the Incarnate Word campus. During the study abroad experience, students participate in German language courses and visit numerous museums and historical venues while enjoying the best of local food and culture. Previous trips featured the European Parliament, Struthof Concentration Camp, Heidelberg Castle, and a solar boat tour on the Necker River.

JAPANESE EXCHANGE PROGRAM

St. Anthony offers eligible students an opportunity to study abroad in Kumamoto, Japan. Eligibility is based on students' academic record, behavior record, and enrollment in the Japanese II language course.
